

## Useful Autograph tools for IWBs

### Whiteboard view



This gives thicker lines, bigger fonts, no need to shift-select multiple objects and access to the on-screen keyboard.

### On-screen keyboard



The on-screen keyboard can also be accessed with View > Keyboard. The Text and Data buttons expand the keyboard. The keyboard can be used in other applications.

### Constant controller



The constant controller allows parameters to be varied.

### Scribble tool



The scribble tool is a useful pen that can be used on top of any graph and the annotations don't disappear when the graph is edited.

### Object menu

The Object menu has the same effect as right-clicking an object.

### Slow-plot



The turtle enables slow-plot which plots the graph from left-to-right. This can be used to encourage students to predict the behaviour of curves.

### Edit axes



Appearance > Theme > Graph paper displays well on an IWB.

Hint: You can save a blank template to your desktop and open this directly.
