

Get Set for the 2017 maths A levels

This programme of four one-day courses is designed to help teachers of A level Mathematics prepare for the new specifications.



It is appropriate for all specifications.

- **Principles of the new mathematics A levels: 15th May 2017, 10am-4pm**
The day will focus on practical ways of planning for the changes to A level Mathematics, with an emphasis on embedding the three overarching themes of mathematical reasoning, problem solving and modelling in order to prepare students for the new qualifications.
- **Mechanics: 14th June 2017, 10am-4pm**
Aimed at teachers who have not previously taught mechanics, the day will get them started in thinking about the basic concepts of motion and force by looking at some classroom activities and ideas for teaching.
- **Statistics: 5th June 2017, 10am-4pm**
We will look at the main statistics topics within A level Mathematics and opportunities for using technology and large data sets in your teaching.
- **Effective use of technology in the new maths A levels, including the large data set: 25th September 2017, 10am-4pm**
We will look at a range of strategies you could use in your department to ensure the use of technology permeates the study of A level Mathematics.
