



# Teaching GCSE Mathematics

Course aims:

- Reflect upon creating effective and engaging environments for learning maths
- Learn more about the principles of effective pedagogy in maths teaching
- Apply these principles in the classroom with practical strategies and resources
- Gain confidence and competence with the subject content of KS4 maths up to, and including, higher tier GCSE
