

Making Effective Use of the Oak Primary Maths Resources

Academic year: 2026–27

Course Overview

The four sessions are designed for maths leaders and teachers who are looking to implement the Oak National Academy Primary Maths resources in their school and their work.

Over two months, the course supports participants to develop their understanding of the structure of the Oak Primary Maths Curriculum, how it links to other materials from the Department for Education and the NCETM (National Centre for Excellence in the Teaching of Mathematics).

Features of the course include:

- A structured programme of online session to explore the structure and effective implementation of the Oak National Academy Primary Maths resources
- Opportunities to discuss strategies and approaches
- Support for teachers and leaders of mathematics

All sessions will start at **15:45** on a **Tuesday** and run for **90 minutes**.
