Course Overview

Develop an understanding of the expectations of the adult maths curriculum.

Designed for teachers working in adult settings, this course explores the pedagogy of maths mastery and how to maximise opportunities for learners. You'll develop practical approaches to teaching Functional Skills and GCSE Mathematics while building learners' confidence, reasoning and problem-solving skills.
