

Teaching GCSE Mathematics Resit

Academic year: 2026–27

Course Overview

Develop your confidence in teaching GCSE Mathematics foundation tier to resit students in Further Education, building your knowledge, skills, and strategies over time to support their success.

You will explore key aspects of proportional reasoning, contextualisation, problem-solving, and reasoning, alongside approaches such as diagnostic teaching, the use of manipulatives, bar modelling, and ratio tables. Inclusive pedagogy is embedded throughout, with an emphasis on recognising and addressing common misconceptions and adapting teaching to meet the needs of all learners.

Each session will be followed by a set of modules to complete before the next session. This allows you time to apply ideas between sessions while maintaining regular contact with your peers and tutor.

Format of the course:

- Three online sessions via Zoom and six on-demand modules via MEI's learning platform, Integral
- Each online session will run for 90-minutes
